



Description: Headlight
Part Number: 121054-121146-121053-121216
Application: 1998-2002 Honda Accord



Tool needed: Flat head screw driver, 8mm socket, 10mm socket, wire splicer, electrical tape, scissors/knife

Step 1: Remove the two push pins located on the bumper by the inner headlight housing.



Step 2: Remove the 10mm screw holding the front bumper on both sides.

Step 3: Remove the screw from underneath the vehicle there will be a two at each end.

Step 4: Remove the 5 push pins from under the vehicle with the flat head screwdriver.



Step 5: Push the corner of the bumper down then pull away from the car do the same with the other side.

Step 6: Once both sides are loosened from the frame remove the front bumper.



Step 7: Use the 10mm socket to remove the one screw from the top of the headlight.

Step 8: Remove the one screw on the side of the headlight, this will be holding in the support frame.

Step 9: Remove the two 10mm from under the headlight support frame.



Step 10: Now remove the headlight from the frame.



Step 11: Twist off the Turn signals in the headlight.



Step 12: Twist off the headlight bulbs.



Step 13: Unclip the head light wire harness from the bulbs.



Now your headlight should be able to come right out.



Step 15: Use the scissors to expose the wires from the parking light.



Step 16: Splice the two red wires from the new headlight to the black and red wire to power the halos.





Step 17: Now use electrical tape to prevent any kind of power shortage.



Step 18: Plug in the wire harness into the new Anzo projector headlights.



Step 19: Plug in the wire harness into the new Anzo projector headlights.



Step 20: Twist in the turn signals into the new Anzo projector headlights.



Step 21: Screw in the headlights into the frame.



Step 22: Screw in one screw on the side and the two screws into the headlight support frame.



Step 23: Please check all functions to make sure they are in working order before driving.
